Note:

- i. Since Clerical Cadre recruitment would be on State/UT-wise basis, it will therefore be necessary that candidates apply for vacancies of a State/UT from which they have appeared for the Common Written Examination (CWE) and in which they have qualified.
- ii. The number of vacancies and also the number of reserved vacancies are provisional and may vary according to the actual requirement of the Bank. The number of vacancies can be increased or decreased by the Bank at any stage as per requirement. As the reservation for OH/HI/VH and Ex-Servicemen candidates is on horizontal basis, the selected candidates will be recruited in the appropriate category to which the candidate belongs.

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- iii. Candidates belonging to reserved categories for which no vacancy has been announced are free to apply against vacancies announced for Unreserved /General category provided they fulfill the age and qualification norms of General Category.
- iv. Candidates should be able to read, write and speak the **Regional** language of the State/UT for which vacancies are advertised and for which he/she desires to apply.
- v. Bank reserves its right to ask candidates to write a passage / essay in **Regional** language at the time of interview to ascertain the knowledge of **Regional** language of the candidates.

2. PAY SCALE :-
