With reference to your letter No.SPA/R/2012/R-3383 dated 15th June, 2012 regarding First Admission cut-off percentage of marks and name of the Admission Incharge, the following information is furnished for the session 2012-13.

- 2% relaxation in Cut-Off percentage is allowed for Girl Candidates in all courses.
- OBC Girl candidates are eligible to avail BOTH benefits at a time for getting admission in their respective course (i.e. OBC Benefit and Girl Candidates relaxation).
- Without Book-Keeping/Accountancy & Commerce (Business Studies) 5% marks from aggregate will be deducted i.e. 2% for Commerce and 3% for Accountancy.
- ❖ In case a student has not studied the subject(s) of the BA Prog. papers opted, a deduction of 2.5% marks for each subject will be made. Similarly, a deduction of 5% marks will be made if two subjects of the combination offered have not been studied at +2 level. However, if a candidate has not studied Computer Science at +2 level and he opts it, no deduction shall be made for this. If a candidate opts Mathematics, it is mandatory that he must have studied Mathematics at +2 level.
- Candidates who have not studied Political Science at +2 level will be considered for BA(H) Political Science course after deducting 2.5% marks in the aggregate.
- Candidates who have not studied Economics at +2 level will be considered for BA(H) Economics course after deducting 5% marks in the aggregate.
